This program serves all those in need during the Christmas season. Residents submit a hamper request form and a hamper is then delivered to the household full of gifts, food, and all of the fixings for a Christmas Dinner. This program relies on donations from the community to help make the Christmas season blessed and joyous for everyone. Our warmest thanks and appreciation goes to all of the individuals, businesses, and organizations that have generously supported this program in the past.

DONATIONS of food, gifts, and financial support are accepted at the Town of Bruderheim Administration building (5017 Queen St) from October - December 2011.

FOOD COLLECTION BINS are distributed at local businesses beginning in late October. Although all food donations are appreciated, open food packages and expired goods cannot be accepted. This year collection bins for the Christmas Hamper Program will also be located at the Bruderheim Arena and the Community Hall for the weekend of November 26th, 2011 for the Festival of Trees event.

CHRISTMAS BEAR TREE: Families that have requested a Christmas Hamper are provided with gifts for all children and youth in the home. A Christmas Bear Tree will be placed in the Town of Bruderheim Administration Building beginning on Monday November 28th, 2011. Christmas Bear decorations will be hung on the tree, each with the gender and age of a child or youth needing a gift. Residents may choose a Christmas Bear, purchase a gift, and return the bear and unwrapped gift to the Town of Bruderheim Administration Building by December 12th, 2011.

HAMPER REQUEST FORMS will be available at the Town Office as of November 1st, 2011 and online at www.bruderheim.ca. They may also be picked up from public bulletin boards, at local churches, businesses, and the Bruderheim School.
