



## RE: Proposed Bruderheim Pipeline Laterals Project Open House

CANEXUS Chemicals Canada Limited Partnership (CANEXUS) is proposing to install additional rail lines, transfer facilities, hydrocarbon storage and connecting pipelines to expand the use of our currently established operational infrastructure at the Bruderheim Terminal site. The proposed project will include a rail loop added to the Bruderheim site, with associated loading and unloading facilities, and the installation of two 80,000 barrel storage tanks and a 50,000 barrel storage tank. CANEXUS is also proposing to build a pipeline system with three 8.5 km pipeline laterals transporting condensate, diluted bitumen and water, to connect the CANEXUS Bruderheim Terminal operations facilities with current industry infrastructure in the area.

As part of our public consultation program, an open house will be held in Bruderheim, to offer all project stakeholders the opportunity to learn more about this proposed pipeline project, to discuss any concerns or suggestions you have with the project team, and to provide us your input on this project.
