## NOTES FROM THE TOWN OFFICE

### How to Check for Water Leaks in your Home (water taps and toilets):

- \*Turn off all water taps in your home.
- \*Check the water meter to see if it is still turning. If it is, then you probably have a leak.
- To find a leak in your toilet, you can do one of the following:**
- \*Listen for running water at the toilet.
- \*Put food coloring in the tank and if it runs into the bowl then you have a leak.
- \*Turn the shut off valve behind the toilet off. If you have more than one toilet, do one at a time to isolate which one is leaking and check the meter to see if it is turning. If the meter is turning, you probably have a leak.

### Lawn Care Tip:

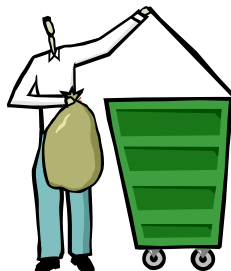
When mulching your lawn, don't bag it. Leaving the grass clippings on the lawn is the most natural and environmental thing to do for the lawn.
