Please have your large items out by 8:00 a.m. Large item pickups include couches, chairs, stoves, old furniture, etc. **NO hazardous items such as paint, varnishes, car batteries, tires, wood with nails, or construction materials will be collected.**

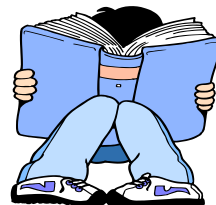
