Practices will be held Mondays and Wednesdays from 6:30-7:30. We are looking for interested adults, parents or teens who are willing to coach or assistant coach. Please email Marilyn at mlenns@hotmail.com for more information.

Fees for all age groups will remain at \$35/child (all ages welcome!). This fee includes insurance coverage for your child in the event of any injuries. Fundraising for the purchase of new equipment for the program is being considered in order to keep our registrations costs low. We are hoping to have games organized with local communities this year as well.

Each child will need their own baseball glove and a good pair of running shoes (no metal cleats). A pelvic protector is recommended but not required. Hats, sunglasses and bug spray are often a good idea along with something to drink. All other ball equipment is provided. If your child wants to use their own bat or batting helmet that is fine, but coaches and BMSA will not be held liable for lost or damaged equipment.

With t-ball we **strongly encourage and welcome** any help on the field from parents.

If it is raining then you can assume that practice is cancelled for that day.
