**TAX NOTICES:**

Combined assessment and tax notices will be sent to all property owners on May 31st, 2011. The 2011 tax levies are due on June 30th, 2011. You may pay your taxes by cheque, cash or debit card at the Town Administration Office during our regular hours of operation. If you are unable to make it into the Town Administration Office during working hours, you may mail your payment or drop it off in the Metro Kalyn Library Drop Box. You may also pay online if you deal with the Scotia Bank, CIBC Bank or Alberta Treasury Branch. On July 1st, 2011 an 18% penalty will be applied to unpaid 2011 tax levy. This includes any balances transfer to your Tax account throughout the year.

On January 1st, 2012 another 18% will be applied to all outstanding amounts on your tax account.

Bylaw Information for the Summer Months: The following bylaw information is pertinent to the warm weather months ahead.



**FIREWORKS Bylaw #744-2004**

The Town may allow for the inclusion of a fireworks display in Town sponsored and/or co-sponsored events. All such events shall be in accordance with the Alberta Fire Code and its regulations and in accordance with those conditions determined solely by the Town. **No other person or organization shall initiate a fireworks display within the Town of Bruderheim limits.**

**PARKING OF TRAILERS**



Trailers **MUST** be attached to the vehicle that will be towing them when they are parked on the street and can only be parked on the street for a 36 hour period.

You can move the trailer and re-park it, but only once in a 7 day period.

No one can occupy a trailer that is parked on any street.



**GARAGE SALE VENDOR INFORMATION GUIDE:**

**LARGE ITEM PICK UP DAY:**



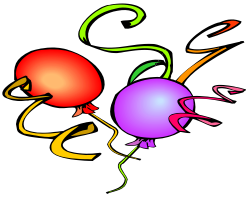
Standstone Waste will be doing a large item pickup day on **Monday, June 6th.**

The Town of Bruderheim (Family and Community Support Services) contracts the Lamont County Region (Family and Community Support Services) to provide these summer programs in our community.

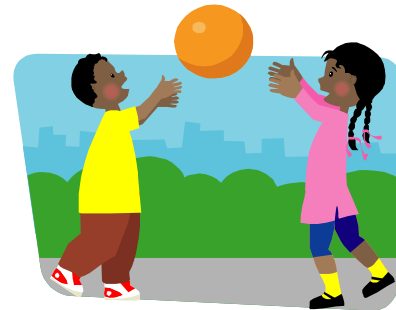
