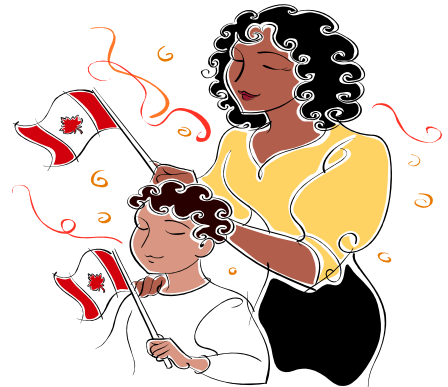

**Parade Participant Guidelines and Information:**

1. **Persons participate in the Canada Day Parade at their own risk.** The Town of Bruderheim and the Community Services Advisory Board are not responsible for the actions of parade participants or for any injuries or damages as a result of participation in the parade.
2. Marshalling will take place in the parking area of Walker School. You will be advised of your parade number when you register with the parade marshall on the morning of the event.
3. All parade entries should be in place by **10:30 a.m.**
4. **Judging** for the parade categories will take place from 10:30 am to 11:00 am. Ribbons and trophies will be awarded in each of the categories (Best Club or Organization Entry, Best Commercial or Municipal Entry, Best Agricultural Entry, Best Novelty Entry, Best Vehicle Entry, Best Horse Entry, Best Theme Entry and Best Float Entry). Awards will be presented prior to the parade so that the ribbons and/or trophies may be displayed during the parade.
5. For safety reasons, **novelties and candies MUST NOT BE THROWN from floats.** Participants walking in the parade may pass out treats **by hand** to spectators. **Serious** safety concerns arise due to children rushing toward the vehicles and/or large animals as candy is being thrown or being hit by these items as they are thrown to the crowd. **We ask that all parade participants comply with this important regulation to ensure a safe and enjoyable parade for everyone.**
6. It is recommended that persons riding in vehicles or floats sit or be provided with and use handrails or other devices which secure them from falling.
7. The inclusion/use of water pistols, water balloons, and/or super soakers is **not** permitted.
8. We ask that all parade participants follow the direction of parade personnel in the assembly area and/or along the route regarding placement, pace, etc.
