

LARGE ITEM GUIDELINES

Leave items at the curbside by 7:00 a.m. and we will haul them away for you. Items may be collected by different trucks.

Special notes:

- Houses with back alleys must have large items put out at **front** of your property for collection.
- Put a note on items (basketball and hocket nets, lawn mowers, wheelbarrows, rain barrels, bicycles etc.) to help identify it as being out for pick up.
- All items must be less than 6 feet by 3 feet (1.8 metres x 0.9 metres) and weigh less then 200 lbs. (90 kg).

Some examples of acceptable items for collection include:

- Stoves
- Washer and dryers
- Mattress and box springs
- Furniture
- Sinks
- Toilets

- Barbecues (no tanks)
- Lawnmower (all fluid drained)
- Rain barrels
- Snowblower (all fluid drained)
- Lawn furniture
- Wheelbarrow

Different trucks collect different items, and where possible, items are sent to be recycled.

Items which are **not acceptable** for collection include:

Televisions	• Tires
• Stereos	Propane tanks
Computers (monitor, towers, keyboards etc.)	Fridges
Desktop printer	Freezers
Car parts	Air conditioners
Snowmobiles	Items larger than 1.8 metres (6 ft) in length
Assembled swing sets	Items weighing more than 200 lbs.

Various electronics not collected may be e-cycled.
