DEVELOP A BALANCED ECONOMY

GOALS 2022 TO 2026:

#1 - Foster and support local small and medium business development that creates economic growth.

#2 - Attract and encourage large business / industry that brings innovation, diversity and employment.

- Develop and implement a plan that is resourced with staff and budget to create support and revitalizing opportunities for local business.
- Develop and implement a strategy to effectively attract new small and large business.



BUILD A SAFE & ENERGETIC COMMUNITY

Bruderheim is a safe and caring community that supports connectivity and well being of our residents. It is a welcoming environment with diverse cultures.

GOALS 2022 TO 2026:

#1 - Provide a positive culture of well being that encourages connection and safety with a focus on people with needs in our community.

#2 - Support and collaborate with partners to create social services and housing that is affordable and appropriate to changing demographics and the needs of our residents.

#3 - Encourage an understanding and appreciation of rural and agricultural roots, our heritage and reconciliation between cultures in our region.

- Develop a Ten-Year Capital Plan to create infrastructure for increased residential and potential new business development.
- Implement phase two of the Parks and Recreation plan to continue community enhancement and environmental initiatives.





PURSUING EXCELLENCE IN MUNICIPAL LEADERSHIP

Bruderheim seeks to provide open and transparent administration and council leadership that listens and responds actively to its citizens. We strive to create fair and principled treatment in our inclusive community.

GOALS 2022 TO 2026:

#1 - Provide stable government and a strong operational process for residents and business.

#2 - Provide a Council and workplace environment that is respectful, promotes professional development and encourages innovation and efficient use of resources.

#3 - Collaborate with other regional leaders at all levels of government to create a stronger local social and business support structure.
