Conditions of Permit

The Chief Administrative Officer or his/her designate may refuse or withdraw an Over-limit Permit if

- The Chief Administrative Officer or his/her designate receives bona fide complaints from two or more residents living adjacent to the Over-limit Permit holder's residence, or
- The permit holder shelters dogs in excess of the number by the Over-limit Permit: or
- The permit holder is guilty of an offence pursuant to Section 6 of this Bylaw

If the Chief Administrative Officer or his/her designate does not approve the Over Permit Application the applicant will receive a refund. If the Chief Administrative Officer or his/her designate revokes the Over-limit Permit, no refund of the Over-limit Permit fees shall be made.

All permits issued shall be valid for a period not exceeding 12 months from the date of issue.
